The Friends of Concord-Carlisle Fields, the Auction Committee, and the donor are not responsible for any personal injuries or damage that may result from the use of any item, property, or service sold. The Friends of Concord-Carlisle Fields reserves the right to withdraw any item at any time before the actual sale and to reject a bid from any bidder.

Raffle drawings will occur during Opening Day on June 8th between noon and 4pm. **All purchased goods and services must be used within one year of the auction unless otherwise indicated.** Dates and time are to be arranged at the mutual convenience of the donor and the buyer. It is the buyer's responsibility to make arrangements.

No pets, smoking, singles' parties are allowed in the house or condominium packages. Also, unless otherwise specified, no alcoholic beverages or gratuities are included in the meal and restaurant donations. All alcoholic beverages offered at auction can only be purchased and consumed by people of legal age.

SILENT AUCTION

Potential buyers should enter their name and telephone number and the bid amount on the bid sheet located next to each silent auction item. All bids must be in whole dollar amounts. Each succeeding bid must equal or exceed the required minimum bid increment shown on the bid sheet. Bids will be disqualified if the required minimum bid is not made.

You may bid as often as you like on as many items as you wish. Once your bid is entered on the bid sheet, it may not be withdrawn. Your bid is your obligation to buy.

Items will be awarded to the highest bidder entered on the sheet at closing. No bidding will be allowed after closing at 3:00pm on June 8th. At that time, a member of the Auction Committee will circle the highest bid and remove the bid sheet to the cashier's table. Full payment for all items must be made by 4pm on June 8th. Each successful bidder must pay by cash or personal check and remove the purchased item at the end of the celebration, if possible.

In the event of a dispute, the Chair of the Auction Committee shall determine the winning bid. The numbers will be available at the cashier's table after the Silent Auction has closed.
